

DANISH WINDMILL

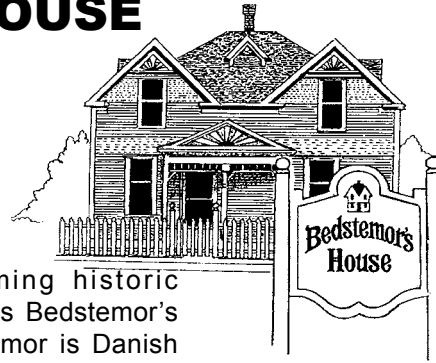
From Nørre Snede, Denmark, to Elk Horn, Iowa, a 60' Danish windmill has found a new home. Elk Horn residents raised over \$100,000 to relocate the 1848 mill from Denmark to Elk Horn in 1976.



The windmill has become one of the largest tourist attractions in Iowa. Visitors can climb to the top of the mill, see the grinding stones and watch the wings go around on a windy day.

Over one million tourists have visited the mill since its doors opened. The mill house gift shop has lovely Danish collectibles, books, jewelry, food and unique gift items. The mill is open daily.

BEDSTEMOR'S HOUSE



The charming historic home known as Bedstemor's House (bedstemor is Danish for grandmother) is owned and operated by The Danish Immigrant Museum. It is completely furnished in the period between 1910 and 1920 when young Danish American families lived there.

Bedstemor's House is open for tours May through September.

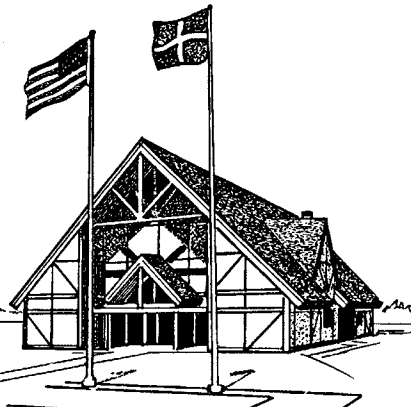


THE DANISH IMMIGRANT MUSEUM

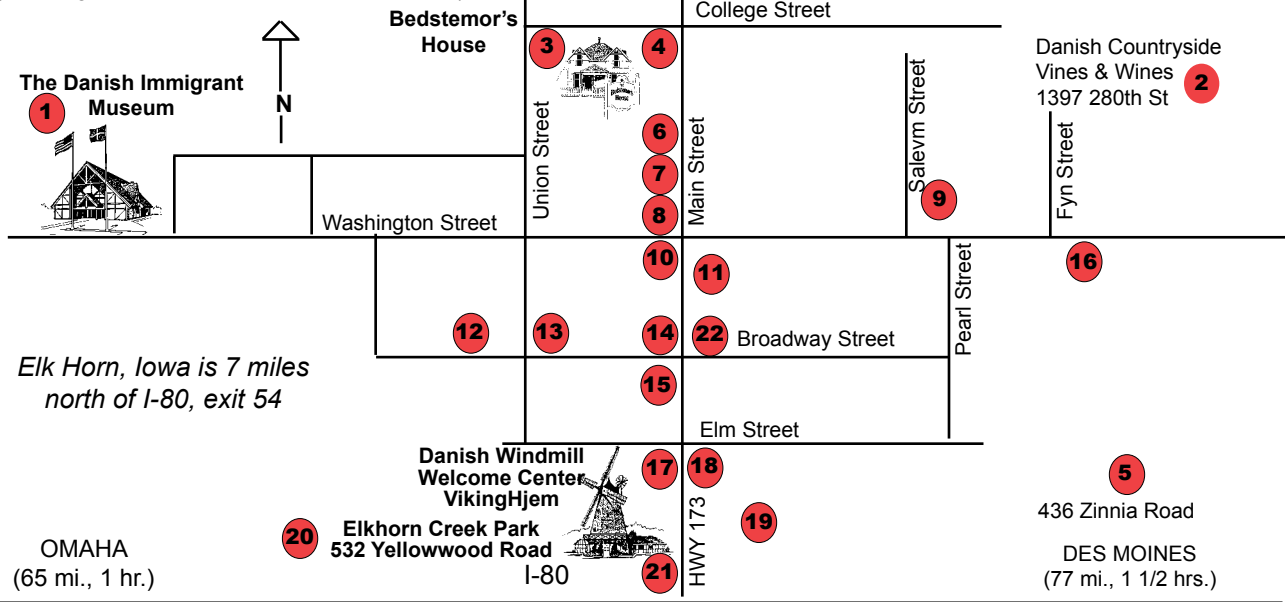
JULEFEST
