

Elk Horn's Danish Windmill is America's only authentic Danish Windmill. The Mill, originally built in Nørre Snede, Denmark in 1848, was brought to the United States, and rebuilt by community volunteers in 1976.

The mill was restored to working condition and operates as an educational and historical museum of Danish cultural heritage welcoming over 60,000 visitors a year.
