

## Danish Windmill

Originally built in Nørre Snede, Denmark in 1848, this authentic Danish windmill was taken apart, shipped across the Atlantic, and put back together by volunteers in 1976. Elk Horn residents raised over \$100,000 for the project and today

the 60' windmill towers over downtown Main Street, greeting all visitors from the interstate. Open daily, the windmill is one of the largest tourist attractions in Iowa with well over a million visitors since its doors opened. Visitors can climb to the top of the mill, walk around the catwalk, view the grindstones, and even watch the wings go around on a windy day. The millhouse gift shop offers lovely Danish collectibles, books, jewelry, apparel, food, and other unique gift items. Also on the grounds, a 9th-century replica Vikinghjem, the Morning Star Tiny Chapel, and Ebeltoft Village are open seasonally.

# Museum Of Danish America



Continually revamped exhibits fill three floors, sharing the stories of Danish Americans from all across

the U.S. Journey through 14,000 years of history in a 90-foot timeline wrapped around a glass room holding some of the museum's expansive artifact collection. This national museum is accredited - a distinction held by fewer than 3% of all U.S. museums! Don't miss the contemporary Design Store, the LEGO play area, and the 35-acre park with a paved trail, picnic areas, homesteaders' cabin, fitness equipment, and a green roof. Visit its Genealogy Center on Main Street for an exhibit on the history of the Danish Villages, plus professional research assistance and extensive family history resources.

# Bedstemor's House

This charming historic home is completely furnished in the style of the period between 1910 and 1920 when Danish immigrants

lived there. Bedstemor's House is open between Memorial Day and Labor Day.






# Elk Horn, Iowa
